**Required Forms-** All Students trying out for sports **MUST** have the following forms on file with the Athletic Director prior to tryouts:

1. Current FHSAA Physical Form (EL2)
2. FHSAA Consent & Liability/Concussion & Sudden Cardiac (EL3)
3. HC / Transportation Form
4. Participation Contract Form

### **New Required FHSAA Video "Concussion In Sports"-**

**ATTENTION** - Important Information for all students! Any student trying out for a sport must complete the mandatory FHSAA "Concussion In Sports" video each school year before they can tryout. The video can be located at :

**To participate in Athletics-** All Seventh and Eighth grade students must have been promoted with at least a 2.0 grade point average (GPA) to be eligible in the Fall. If the GPA falls below 2.0 during the 1st semester, suspension or removal from the team may occur.

\* If the student does not have a 2.0 GPA in the Fall, he/she may become eligible at the beginning of the 2nd semester, if he/she has a 2.0 grade point average (GPA) and did not participate in any sports the previous year. (FHSAA Bylaw 11.2.14)

***Sixth Grade*** - Unfortunately, county policy states that incoming 6<sup>th</sup> graders are **NOT** eligible to participate or act as managers on the competitive athletic teams. There are opportunities to participate in the Annual County 6<sup>th</sup> Grade track meet and in Intramurals as offered.

**Students assume a special role** when wearing the uniform for OLJH. An athlete is expected to govern their conduct in accordance with the rules and regulations of the "Athletic Participation Agreement" Violations of the student athlete's obligations as outlined in the agreement may result in removal from competitive athletics.
